



**Mission report  
Pakistan earthquake 2005  
Kashmir region**

Upon request received from the Pakistan Country Office WFP-UNHRD deployed four staff members in the earthquake affected region of Kashmir in Pakistan. The staff members namely, Giuseppe Colavita, Nunzio Melacca, Vincenzo Gaudiano, Giuseppe Maci, left in groups of two people each on different dates.

The terms of reference of the above-mentioned staff members were to install storage tents, as well as Living and Office accommodation units, and conduct at the same time a full fledged training to the local nationals.

Once in Islamabad the Emergency Logistics Unit has split the staff members in two groups. It was agreed that Giuseppe Colavita and Giuseppe Maci would go to the north and ewhereas Nunzio Melacca and Vincenzo Gaudiano would take care of the southern area of Kashmir.

Giuseppe Colavita and Giuseppe Maci moved to Muzaffarabad on 27.10.2005. Upon arrival the team touched basis with the management at the SRSA Camp. During the following 6 days the team installed 2 rubb halls for UNICEF (1 at the airport and 1 at the Warehouse) and 1 Wiikhall for WFP at the warehouse. The decision to install 2 rubbhalls for UNICEF was taken by the Logistics Officer.

Right after that, the team decided together with the Logistics officer to move to Bagh. The reason for that was because 3 wiikhalls available in Muzaffarabad were missing several essential parts, which were then found in Mansehra.

The first mission to Bagh lasted 4 days during which the team installed one Wiikhall for WFP at the warehouse and completed one wiikhall for WHO (borrowed from WFP). Due to the fact that the other wiikhalls for Bagh had not arrived the team decided, in accordance with the Bagh Logistics Officer, to go back to Muzaffarabad.
